Dog Days—A Doggie Daycare



In 2007, we are continuing the membership program begun in 2004. It provides the drop-in convenience expected and appreciated by our clients; and helps us maintain the number of dogs per day to a manageable and fun level.

1. Term: Jan 2007-Dec 2007.
2. Membership is per dog. Additional dog memberships in the same family are half price.
3. Cost: \$50 for first pet and \$25 for each additional pet
  - a. Waived for monthly dogs (dogs that pay a monthly fee)
  - b. No Prorate
4. Most daycare and boarding slots are for members---non-members may come to daycare on a first reserved first served basis. Standing weekly appointments are accepted.
5. Member dogs pay a reduced rate for daycare.
6. RESERVATIONS FOR NON-MEMBERS ARE REQUIRED AND FINANCIALLY BINDING.
7. Members do not need reservations for daycare.
8. For proper staffing, we request Reservations for Boarding (Holiday & Non-Holiday).
9. All Holiday Boarding is Members Only.

Requirements  
All Dogs Must Be:

1. Healthy
2. Spayed or Neutered by 6 months of age
3. Social to other dogs and Responsive to human commands (or working on it!)
4. On Flea/Tick Treatment (we prefer Advantage, Frontline, or Bio-Spot)
  - o Naturopathic remedies are allowed, but we must feel comfortable with your treatment. preventative or
  - o If we find fleas on your dog, we will treat it at your expense.
5. Current on vaccinations/Vet Care
  - a. REQUIRED
    - i. Heartworm Preventative (monthly tablet)
    - ii. Distemper Parvo Vaccine Series—within 12 months (we do accept titers)
    - iii. Rabies—within 12 months (required by AR law)
    - iv. Kennel Cough (Bordatella) within 6 months
    - v. Veterinary care as we see appropriate (i.e. if we notice worms in your dogs stool, we require you to get medication from your vet prior to your dog's return to daycare).
  - b. RECOMMENDED BUT NOT REQUIRED
    - i. Lyme vaccine
    - ii. Annual Fecal Test and/or wormers
6. Not wearing Flea/Tick Collars (for the health and safety of their doggie wrestling buddies—you wouldn't like the taste of a flea collar either!)
7. Wearing Identification Tags. We will provide a tag for your dog at no charge.
